***Project Overview***

The South Galilee Coal Project (SGCP) is the name of a proposed new coal mine that will be situated to the south-west of Alpha. AMCI (Alpha) Pty Ltd (AMCI) and Alpha Coal Pty Ltd (Bandanna Energy) have formed a joint venture to investigate the feasibility of a new mine in this area.

Both AMCI and Bandanna Energy look forward to developing relationships with the local community and propose to establish a Community Reference Group (CRG) to provide a formal communications process between directly and indirectly affected landholders, local community representatives including traditional owners, local government, conservation groups and a cross section of other key individuals and groups, to represent the broad community interests. The CRG will be an open and honest forum for discussing all aspects of the SGCP and beyond.

***CRG Objectives***

The objectives of the CRG are to:

- provide factual, accurate information about the projects and any environmental, social and economic impacts;
- identify and understand existing community values and concerns;
- identify and discuss any issues of concern;
- rapidly develop strategies to mitigate any potential negative impacts;
- demonstrate that the opinions and views of the local community will be considered during the planning and operation of both projects;
- encourage a level of confidence within the community that the mining operations are environmentally responsible;
- liaise with established CRGs from nearby mines where there is the potential for cumulative impacts, for sharing information; and
- foster long term collaborative relationships with the local community and AMCI.
